The logbook allows the user to record information on medical certificates/notes, qualifications/ certifications, training, competence, record of dives, record of medical illness and cumulative diving experience.














SY-IMCA- Diving supervisor's logbook

This logbook is ideal for recording information concerning training, competence, qualifications, certificate of medical fitness to work offshore and tour of duty.



This logbook is to be completed in line with Guidance on competence assurance and assessment: Diving Division


Users will need to complete information for eye test record, qualifications, training, competence, record of inspection, non-destructive testing (NDT) and diving inspection summary.

This logbook is Crane logbook (for offshore vessels) intended to assist vessel operators and masters by providing a format for keeping a useful record of the operational history of cranes on vessel.

It also allows the user to detail incidents and other information that may affect the crane.

Users will be expected to log information concerning qualifications, training, competence assessment records, previous experience and crane operations.

SY-IMCA- Offshore manager's logbook


This logbook has been developed in partnership with the Marine Safety Forum (MSF) and is intended for use by any mariner working offshore in a managerial role who wishes to maintain a record of work experience not applicable to other current IMCA logbooks. This may include, but is not limited to, those in the roles of: tow master, client representative, marine consultant, marine warranty surveyor, marine superintendent and marine accident investigator

The logbook contributes to the competence recording set out in the IMCA competence assurance and assessment guidance.








SY-IMCA- Life support technician's logbook

This logbook is to be completed in line with Guidance on competence assurance and assessment: Diving Division.

It allows the user to record information concerning their LST career, certificate of medical fitness to work offshore, qualifications, training, competence assessment as well as tour of duty record.





SY-IMCA- Offshore engineer's logbook

This logbook is to be completed in line with Guidance on competence assurance and assessment: Diving Division.
